During the past year your Committee on the Grand Constitution and By-Laws Committee of Review received no requests for changes to the Grand Council Constitution. We did receive a request for review of a By-Laws amendment from Evening Star Council No. 13 that would reduce the number of Stated Assemblies to three each year plus the Annual Assembly (for a total of four Assemblies each year). The Committee recommended approval, and forwarded the request to MIGM Nathaniel H. Sawyer who promptly approved it.

We thank the Grand Council for the opportunity to serve as the Committee on the Grand Constitution and By-Laws Committee of Review.

To the Most Illustrious Grand Master, Officers, and Members of the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons of New Hampshire.

Your Committee on finance makes the following report. We have audited the books of the Grand Treasurer and find them to be in good order, and in balance. We would like to commend 111 Companion Robinson for the fine work that he has done on the finances of this Grand Council. He has reviewed the various investments that we had and made changes that were needed to put us on a more stable footing. We are please that the new investments replacing some of our more outdated investments will take us in to the future with better returns without the loss of market value as in the past. These new investments have already started to return some of our losses from years past.

Again this last year there will not be a short fall in the budget, due to changes that have taken place in the cost of print and postage, however we should not take that our problems are solved we still need new members.

It is the understanding of the committee that the General Grand Council has proposed an increase in their per capita from \$.35 cents to \$1.00, this increase of \$.65 cents would put us in the red with our budget and require an increase in our per capita of at least a \$1.00 to cover us for a few years in advance.

Recommendation:

1. That any excess of a budgeted item be applied to any other expense incurred at the discretion of the Grand Treasurer.
2. That due the vote of Grand Commandery that they paid the total cost for the fidelity for the fiscal year 2008 with subjection that the Grand Chapter pay fiscal year 2009 and the Grand Council pay 2010. The total cost of this bond being only \$176.00 per year for ALL the York Rite Bodies of NH, equaling what we paid in the past for just the Grand Bodies. No bill to be sent to the local Councils for this fiscal year.

REPORT OF THE GRAND RECORDER

I hereby submit my report as Grand Recorder for the year 2007-2008.

I assumed the Office and procured what records the Grand Recorder Emeritus had. I have supplied an electronic copy of the Proceedings to MIPGM Robert Sutherland, Jr. who will take them and have discs made for distribution. Those desiring a written copy will have to order them from this Office.

We have solved the issue of Ish Sodi Awards and the Grand Council has a supply of Pocket Badges Type. As mentioned in the Unfinished Business Report, we can sell them to the individual Councils for \$10 each beginning this year. We currently have in stock 19 Ish Sodi Awards, and 2 Past Grand Master Aprons. As stated earlier, we can order neck ribbon Ish Sodi Jewels at \$20 each for those who prefer that style.

Companion David Collins has offered the Grand Bodies a policy to replace the fidelity Bond we had previously. The Grand Commandry has paid the initial bill for such and the Councils will be billed accordingly. This change of Insurance Companies has saved us all substantially and the policy is for 3 years.

I must complain that I have received no Officers Reports on a timely notice. The Grand Constitution states that all Visiting Officers are to send in their reports with the Council's copy of a financial statement no later than 10 days following the Visitation. Only our Grand Principle Conductor of the Work has sent in reports, but all at once at the end of the season.

I am sorry that the Grand Officer Training Program has not continued, as it should. It would be my hope that is rectified in the future. Also, I recommend that the Grand Master consider beginning Semi-Annual Convocation of the Grand Council to keep all Officers and members current on the present situations. I do not believe we meet enough in this capacity. Perhaps an October meeting should be considered. Also take note that we had a very hard winter and traveling during snow months does not bring out as many to the Visitations.

To the Most Illustrious Grand Master, Officers, and Companions of the Grand Council Cryptic Masons of New Hampshire:


The Jurisprudence Committee submits the following report relative to the activities of our Most Illustrious Grand Master during the Cryptic Year ending today.
