I have served this past year as the Chair for the Cryptic Masons Medical Research Foundation.

Only one check made its way to me this year for reporting purposes, and that was actually a donation made by Scenic Council, Knight Masons.

Observations:

1) The Grand High Priest's message of "just do the work" is resonating amongst the companions and York Rite as a whole. He is to be commended. Additionally, every officer must make this part of their mantra in continuing into the future. Doing the work=getting better at the work.

2) I made a recommendation in the past that we (the York Rite leaders) should formulate a strategic plan; I stand by that recommendation of formulating a strategic plan that will actually work and be productive for us as a rite. It is feasible and frankly, imperative.

3) It was nice to see the special work of the Super Excellent Master degree done in Concord this year. It had been at least a few years since it was performed and it was done well. The key to its

success however, will be in terms of observation 1: doing the work. If we do it more frequently, we'll get better at it, and it will become more proficient with it. It's also an enjoyable allegory as well, and we can all stand to use some of the moral lessons this degree encapsulates.

4) The CMMRF is a valuable charity and one which does some pretty amazing work. I am sorry that we did not raise more money for it this year; I am hopeful we will in the future. To that extent I hope the incoming Grand Master and all Grand Officers will discuss the good works of this charity whenever they are able.

I would be remiss if I did not conclude my report without some acknowledgment of our Grand Master and what a privilege it has been to work with him over the year. I have been very fortunate to work with MI Walters since I began my York Rite journey, and even before that in Blue Lodge. His dedication to the craft is undaunted and he served our Grand Council and the state of New Hampshire very well this year. Well done sir; it was an honor to serve you.

Lastly, many of us have varying responsibilities among all aspects of the Craft, and that is truly laudable. We must remember however not to spread too thinly, else we try to give too much to too many and we run out of support behind us. Strengthening the York Rite at all levels, and Craft Masonry at large, will solve those problems. We will all undoubtedly remain overactive, but we will remain so knowing that we are doing good work, square work.

My Observations for this past year and embedded recommendations, apply to not only Council, but all the bodies within New Hampshire York Rite:

- The status of Council in the state is at the proverbial fork in the road. As has been said in the recent years; our actions now will have lasting consequences. Inaction, is not an option if we are to survive. While we have some pockets of our groups who are doing well, we have room for improvement. Let us look to emulate that which is working and try to grow it in other location councils. There has been a positive reception to the "round table" discussion/informal gatherings. Those who are taking this approach have seen growth in new membership and others should look to institute it within their local bodies. Time is of the essence; we must do or act, the time for talk is behind us!
- Communication is sporadic among all levels. While some are doing a better job than others, there is much room to improve. I have heard from many companions who do find

the technological means to be insufficient. It can be an impersonal means of communicating and that is not lost on the companions. It is not news, but we need to all pick up the phone and talk with those members we have not seen recently. It goes a long way to helping to make those companions feel that they matter. Don't forget communication extends beyond our current membership. You need to ask when was the last time you spoke with your local lodge about York Rite and Templary?

## **Report of the Finance Committee**

### ***To the Most Illustrious Grand Master, Grand Officers and Companions of the Grand Council Cryptic Masons of New Hampshire:***

Your Finance Committee met with our Grand Treasurer R.I. Companion Verne S. Anderson, Jr. for the purpose of auditing the Grand Council's financial records for the past fiscal year. We have found the financial records in excellent condition and most easy to audit. We also reviewed the past and current investments of our Grand Council. We find that our current investments have been carefully invested and are providing very nice returns. We have suggested that reviewing the current investment company over the next few years as to its overall value to the Grand Council.

Your Committee also prepared a recommended budget for the ensuing year of 2017-18 that will be presented for your consideration and acceptance. We are well aware that costs continue to increase and though times are tight for everyone, it is not to increase the per capita. The ability to not increase is due to our dropping support for the General Grand Council, We have taken the cost of the GGC and increase several line items that have been undervalued over the years/

The cost of this year grand session has been greatly reduced and that helped offset many of the added costs. The cost of the insurance binder this year was that of the Commandery and will be Chapter next. We have a pressing issue of what we are going to do the items that are being store in the back room of a faithful Companion and need to be moved.

We recommend continuing the efforts in reducing the expenditures of the Grand Council with continued emphasis on the following items as has been done in the past year. We did feel that we have shortchanged some areas in the past and have made changes in those areas. In past years we have not put any money in the budget for our Grand Officers expenses to travel to the North East Conference training, and increase the money for the MIGM for him to do as much travel as he can. At this Conference our Grand Officers meet with their counterparts, share experiences of their successes, failures and discuss what can be done to turn negatives into positives. Valuable training is available throughout the conference for our current and future leaders. We have included a \$600.00 for the MIGM's expenses. We are well aware that he does much at his own expense.

- 1) Create and maintain a MailChimp (or equivalent technology) email list to inform every Companion and Sir Knight of events and happening within the state.
- 2) Create a basic but informative one page, trifold brochure highlighting the York Rite and what we are about.
- 3) Create a plan to have several “informational” nights around the state to heavily advertise them to lodge in the state. If this is well organized and planned it could be highly beneficial.
- 4) All local bodies consider having an informal meeting on dark months to discuss or rehearse ritual, have general fellowship and/or plan for the future.

5) Foster and support a NH Drill Team for Commandery.

Some other things that will take some time are:

- 1) Getting the Chapter and Council ritual into a corrected and printed form. On demand publishing is a good way to accomplish this with very little upfront costs.
- 2) In chapter create MMM, PM and MEM opening and closing rituals based upon current GL of NH blue lodge openings and closings. This is something many other jurisdictions have done and think was lost in ours over time.
- 3) Survey the membership about needs and desires. Compile the data and make a plan to act upon it.

Lastly, we all from our newest companions on up, need to become cheerleaders for the superb message our degrees and orders have to give. I am mostly preaching to the choir but if we all do a little we can accomplish a lot! If each one of us finds an opportunity to talk about the York Rite with our brethren that not yet members, it will make a big difference. Educate yourself and others by forming these discussion groups, become champions of our cause! Hope is eternal please keep it alive by assisting wherever you can within the length of you cabletow!

## **REPORT OF THE JURISPRUDENCE COMMITTEE Council – 2017**

*To Companion David R. Walters, Most Illustrious Grand Master, and the Companions of the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons of New Hampshire:*

The Jurisprudence Committee reviewed the report of the Most Illustrious Grand Master's activities for the 2016-2017 Cryptic year and thanks him for its timely submission. This Committee appreciates the opportunity to evaluate the Most Illustrious Grand Master's activities when adequate time is available for review.

The Committee reviewed the By-laws changes and appointments approved by the Illustrious Grand Master and finds them to be appropriate and within the purview of his authority. Your Committee appreciated the requests for assistance made to it during consideration of the By-laws changes.

The Committee notes the Illustrious Grand Master's absence from the Annual Northeast York Rite Conference in Massachusetts and attendance at only two Annual Assemblies of neighboring Grand Councils. The Committee recognizes the travel limitations imposed on presiding Grand Heads by work, family or other commitments. It is suggested when such circumstances arise, effort should be made to the extent possible to ensure a qualified representative is present at those out-of-state events to represent our Grand Council.

The Committee recognizes the award presentations approved by the Illustrious Grand Master and his efforts to ensure qualified nominations were made by constituent Councils. It is critical that the Grand Council is seen as both a resource of support by all Companions, and as a means of officially recognizing the efforts of individuals. Both recipients of the General Grand Council medals are eminently qualified and deserving of their respective awards. Likewise, the two recipients of the Ish Sodi award have both proven themselves to be vital and valuable members of their Councils and well deserving of the recognition.

While the Committee concurs with the Illustrious Grand Master's concerns with visitations and communications among Grand Officers and constituent Councils, the Recommendations section of the report describes a problem but does not offer a tangible, finite solution to fix the problem. It is suggested that this issue be addressed for resolution during the first Grand Officer's meeting. This can be done with clear expectations presented to and understood by all Grand Officers. It is also suggested that the incoming Illustrious Grand Master assign a committee to review the Grand Regulations and more clearly define Grand Officer duties.
